2. Minutes from the last meeting held on 26 Nov 2014 were read and accepted
3. Matters arising: None
4. Finance Statement: GG reported that the account stood at £3464
5. Heritage Area update: TB and MY have checked the site regularly over the winter and cleared watercourses and trimmed fallen trees. TB and MY have moved the bench near the Tally House at the request of Shrops tree consultant. MY has done work on the carpark
6. MY reported that we've been given over £700 worth of maintenance tools by SB. These have been stored in the 'loft'
7. Awards for All. It was agreed that we'd apply for funding for the path over the field from the boardwalk and surfacing of the car park, and maybe more leaflets. MY has obtained rough estimates ... footpath approx. £4500, carpark about £5000. GG will contact CRT (Wendy Capelle) re their permission/(contribution?). It was agreed that we'd look at application in detail at next meeting. JZ will get estimates for leaflets
8. Artist in Residence: The interviews took place on 20 Nov. Mair Hughes from Newtown has been appointed. She met with JZ on 8 Jan for a detailed walk around the site. She is spending January exploring the area and planning her work.
9. Eisteddfod: the group met with Carrie White from Powysland Club on 6 Jan. At her suggestion it was decided that we concentrate on the history of the lime industry. JZ asked for maps, photos etc that could be used. Next meeting 3 Feb, 7.30 in Bradford Arms
10. The 'lime' event on 12 April will be from 1pm – 5pm. It will be called 'Llanymynech Rocks!' The Geology Society will have a stand and will do a geology walk as one of the guided walks. Harriet Devlin has agreed to do Lime talks. Ken Owen will have a stand as will Sylvia Edwards from CRT and Mair Hughes, Artist in Residence. D F-N proposed that Julian ? be approached to show a film in the Hoffmann with appropriate music (and maybe a story!). Linda from Llynclys to be asked to bring her coffee van and Scooperlicious approached for ice cream. Clive Knowles from British Iron Works to be asked
