

**Meeting of the LLIMEYS – Friends of the Llanymynech Limeworks Heritage Area held at 7.30 pm on Wednesday 2 Sep 2015 in the Limeworks Stables, Llanymynech**

**MINUTES**

1. Present: Joan Zorn, Dilys Gaskill, Glyn Gaskill, Tony Beardsell, Martyn Young  
Apologies: Paddy Martin
2. Minutes from the last meeting held on 8 July 2015 were read and accepted
3. Matters arising: DG expressed thanks to JZ for Eisteddfod display. The display panels are now the property of Llimeys, Visitor Centre and History Society and can be borrowed for village events.
4. Finance Statement: GG The balance in the bank is £3334.06. Shrops Council and the Village Hall have been paid £200+ as their share of Stables bookings
5. Heritage Area update: TB/MY reported that they have been tidying, strimming, and putting in new gateposts. There is new fencing at the bottom of the English incline. The post for the main gate from the carpark has been hit by a trailer and the gate is slightly affected  
  
It has been reported that the handrail at the bottom of the steps at Black Bridge is in need of repair.
6. Car park: GG had met with Sarah Lalieu and CRT contractors. It was agreed CRT will look into surfacing car park up to the gate. Wendy Capelle would like to see further development of CRT's part of the Heritage Area adjacent to the canal. GG will liaise with Sarah and TB and MY.  
GG also said that his software for the people counter is no longer working. He can record numbers but not the detailed analysis. An update would cost £1000+ !
7. Volunteer Hours ... these should be forwarded to SB. JZ said that SB should be made aware of the tasks undertaken, particularly by TB and MY.
8. Website: It was agreed that we post Llimeys meetings/agenda/minutes on the site

10. Litter in car park: JZ had reported this and CRT volunteers had removed it. CRT also suggested that in future we could have joint working parties to keep on top of the problem. It was decided that JZ would ask CRT to suggest a date.
