5. Heritage Area Report

MY reported that:

numerous trees have been felled in the Limeworks by the Council, due to disease from Ash Dieback and Dutch Elm disease.

A fallen tree has been cleared in the CRT car park.

The embankment behind the Tally House has been cleared of scrub, to open up the area.

The drainage tank at Black Bridge has been cleared on numerous occasions due to blockages.

The storage area in the Stables Block has been tidied up for use by Birmingham University at the end of March.

A number of logs have been gathered and will be split for use in the Stables Block wood burner.

Litter has been cleared from the Limeworks area.

6. Update on meeting with Shropshire Community Resource
